**Better Gas Safe than sorry.
Your guide to gas safety.**



By law, gas engineers must be on the Gas Safe Register. Always check the card.

Gas Safe Register is the official list of gas engineers who are qualified to work safely and legally on gas appliances. It has replaced CORGI registration. Only use a Gas Safe registered engineer to fit, fix or service your appliances.

All registered engineers can be found on our website or by calling 0800 408 5500. Always check the engineer's Gas Safe Register ID card and check they are qualified for the work you need doing. You can find this information on the back of the card.

Remember to check both sides of the ID card for:

- the licence number
- the start and expiry date
- the security hologram
- the work the engineer is qualified to do
- up-to-date qualifications

Gas engineers must be Gas Safe registered in the United Kingdom, Isle of Man and Guernsey.

KEEP SAFE IN YOUR HOME

Badly fitted and poorly serviced appliances can cause gas leaks, fires, explosions and carbon monoxide poisoning. Carbon monoxide is a highly poisonous gas. You can't see it, taste it or smell it but it can kill quickly with no warning.

- Get your gas appliances regularly serviced and safety checked every year.
- Fit an audible carbon monoxide alarm certified and marked to EN 50291. It should also have the British Standards' Kitemark or another European approval organisation's mark on it.

- Check for warning signs that your appliances are not working correctly e.g. lazy yellow flames or black marks/stains around the appliance.
- Know the six main signs and symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning: headaches, dizziness, nausea, breathlessness, collapse and loss of consciousness.
