QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Before applying to register you will need relevant qualifications, which provide evidence of your competence. Gas Safe Register only accepts evidence of competence in gas safety such as:

ACS

The Nationally Accredited Certification Scheme for Individual Gas Fitting Operatives is generally referred to as ACS. Its primary function is to ensure that individuals are assessed against a set of national criteria based on current standards, best working practice and technology.

NVQ/SVQ

This covers the City and Guilds awarded 6012 range of Gas Service NVQs for:

- the installation and maintenance of domestic natural gas at levels 2 and 3
 - appliance pathway routes
 - emergency service operations.

These are accredited vocational qualifications for a range of gas services.
