

Need a new gas cooker, fire or boiler?

1. Make sure it is installed by a qualified Gas Safe registered engineer.

2. To find or check an engineer, contact Gas Safe Register

3. Check the engineer is suitably qualified.

4. We recommend you get 3 quotes.

5. If the appliance is heat producing (e.g. boiler or fire) your engineer must notify this to your local authority*.



6. You will then receive a Building Regulations Certificate, which you may need when you move home.



7. Arrange to have all your gas appliances checked every year. This could help keep you safe from gas leaks, fires, explosions and carbon monoxide poisoning.



8. Remember to check your engineer's qualifications are still valid before every visit. You can also check this on the back of your engineer's ID card.


