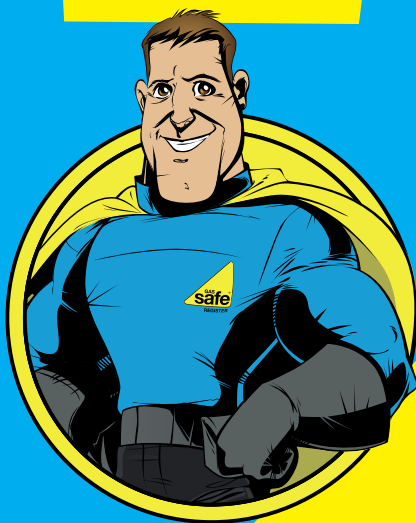

Are you gas safe? Check.

Be risk aware

Unsafe gas appliances can put you at risk of gas leaks, fires, explosions, and carbon monoxide poisoning. Get your gas appliances checked every year by a qualified Gas Safe registered engineer.

Here are some simple checks you can do to help keep you and your loved ones safe:



✓ ***Check that you have had an annual gas safety check***

If you rent, it's your landlord's responsibility to arrange this and provide you with a Gas Safety Record.

✓ ***Check your engineer is Gas Safe registered***

Always verify that the engineer working on your gas appliances is Gas Safe registered and qualified to do the work.

✓ ***Check for warning signs***

Look out for dark, sooty stains around your gas appliances or lazy yellow flames – they should be crisp and blue. These signs may mean your appliance isn't working properly.

✓ ***Check vents are not blocked***

Your gas appliance will need ventilation to work safely. Blocking vents could prevent this.

✓ ***Check your carbon monoxide (CO) alarm***

Install a CO alarm that has a Kitemark to standards BS EN 50291 and regularly check that it is working.

✓ ***Check on your loved ones***

Encourage your family and friends to prioritise gas safety.

Remember every check counts, no matter how big or small.
